Thank you again for registering for the motor tour! As of this update we have 47 cars registered for the tour.

NEW!!! The Thursday Pre-Tour in Clinton will begin at 10:30AM from the Wild Rose Casino & Hotel in Clinton. From there, we will depart and head across the river into Illinois to Fulton to visit the Dutch Windmill & Dutch Heritage Center. Afterward, we will cross the river back into Iowa and view the spot where the old Lyons-Fulton Bridge came across the river. From there we will go a few blocks west and have lunch at Rastrelli's Restaurant. We have reserved a room for our group and will be offered a limited lunch menu to choose from. After lunch, we will head north out of town to either the Wide River Winery or to Eagle Point Park. The park provides a spectacular view of the Mississippi River. The view from the park is the widest point of the entire Mississippi River. Wide River Winery offers samples of delicious wine and a river view as well. The winery is on about 1/2 mile of a hilly gravel road. If you choose not to go to the winery, you can go to the park instead. From there we will head back into Clinton and stop at Smith Brothers General Store, a nostalgic old hardware store with just about everything you could imagine. The pre-tour ends at this point. Please e-mail me if you plan to attend the pre-tour so we can give Rastrelli's an idea of how many people to expect for lunch. I will send out a pre-tour itinerary in a few days

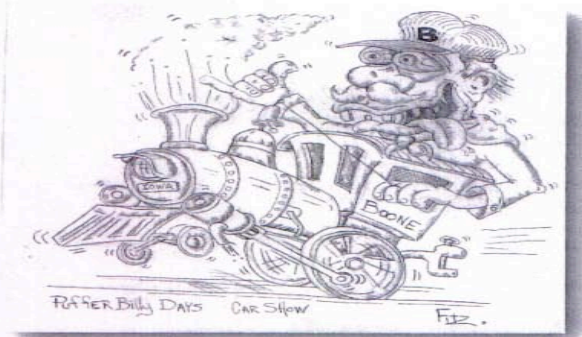
