DAILY TOUR DESCRIPTIONS

Monday June 13

Pre-conference Tour(s) – We will schedule two tours to the Eisenhower National Historic Site; one at 10:00 AM, and one at 1:00 PM. You may choose the one which best fits your schedule. This tour will be to the home and farm of President and Mrs. Dwight Eisenhower – the home in which they lived during his Presidency until the end of their lives. Please plan to meet the conference representative in the main lobby of the Gettysburg National Military Park Visitor Center 15 minutes before your tour begins. You will be taken by bus from there to the Eisenhower Home, and will be returned there at the conclusion of the tour. The average time for the tour is 1-1/2 to 2 hours, and does include walking and stairs.

Tuesday June 14

The bus tour west will include the Lincoln Highway sites between Gettysburg and the Lincoln Highway Experience museum near Latrobe, PA. Included along this stretch are Chambersburg, the Tuscarora Mountain lookout over McConnellsburg, Breezewood (The Town of Motels), Everett, Bedford with Dunkle's Gulf station and The Coffee Pot, the Jean Bonnet Tavern, Lincoln Highway Motor Court, the Ship Hotel site, Mr. Ed's Elephant Farm, and more! Lunch will be provided at the Lincoln Highway Experience. This tour will also visit Flight 93 National Memorial, site of one of the 9-11 airliner crashes, which is located along the Lincoln Highway Corridor.

Wednesday June 15

This bus tour will visit the historic cities of York and Lancaster as it heads east from Gettysburg. You will experience the magnificent Susquehanna River bridge, and the unique and fascinating Shoe House as you pass into the world-famous Pennsylvania Dutch portion of the state. In keeping with the flavor of the area, you'll have lunch at Miller's Smorgasbord, and will be able to explore and shop in several of the small Pennsylvania Dutch villages along the way, experiencing life as if you turned back the hands of time.

Thursday June 16

Thursday will begin with several seminar speakers at the Conference Center. Shortly after 10:00 AM, we will board buses bound for the Gettysburg Military Park Visitor Center. There you will have several hours to explore the vast museum complex, view the film, and see the famous Cyclorama – a 1880s painting 'in the round' of the Battle of Gettysburg - high atop the building. Following lunch, we'll again board the buses for an afternoon tour of the military park narrated by a Licensed Battlefield Guide. It will be an experience you'll long remember.

Friday June 17

Those who wish to extend their vacation are encouraged to travel 125 miles from Gettysburg to Cumberland, Maryland to participate in the National Road – Route 66 – Lincoln Highway Tour. This event will begin Friday evening with a dinner at an old National Road hotel & tavern, followed by a week-long, 875 mile excursion through six states. You'll experience the original historic National Road as it travels through Maryland, Pennsylvania, West Virginia, Ohio, Indiana and Illinois. Then you'll hook-up with historic Route 66, following it north through The Land of Lincoln, finally connecting back with the Lincoln Highway at Joliet, Illinois on Friday, June 24th.
